

CNA Internships: The placements are all based on availability and the ability of the CNA students as evaluated by the instructors. (This is direct patient care!)

- First of all we are a testing site for the Geriatric Nursing Assistant NATIONAL Certification (this is an option in the fall for all successful CNA students and costs \$95)
- Some of the top CNA students assist in surgery (and sometimes in the past delivery)
- CNA certified students may get training and do Phlebotomy, EKG's and other Health Tech duties
- CNA certified students may work in doctor's offices
- CNA certified students may work at a nursing homes
- CNA certified students may be placed at the wound center, outpatient care, post-op. and many other places in the hospital
- CNA certified students also may get a front office assignment

Physical Rehab Internships: The placements are all based on availability and the ability of the students as evaluated by the instructor. (this is direct patient care!)

- Successful physical rehab students may work at the wellness center or healthcare center at a retirement home
- Successful physical rehab students may work at Central MD Rehab, MD Sports Care, or Nova Care with outpatient treatment
- Successful physical rehab students may rotate through the county at participating high schools with the athletic trainer.
