PREREQUISITES

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Academy of Health Prof. (Honors)- Human Anatomy Academy of Health Prof. (Career Certification)- Biology (Academic) Biomedical Science - Algebra II by January of junior year. Students are required to take a college prep math and science class each year of H.S. Cosmetology - it is recommended that students take Human Anatomy and Physiology but it is NOT a requirement. Engineering - Algebra II by January of junior year. Students are required to take a college prep math and science class each year of high school. Print Production - Principles of Art, Media, and Communications (1 credit) OR Honors Commercial Art (1 credit)
